


QUALITY OF CARE REPORT 2022/23

We received no additional comments via email as invited.







2. I am happy with the development opportunities my child has access to at Les Tous.



PARENT FEEDBACK SUMMARY

From the feedback we have been given we feel that our quality of care is of a very high standard.

All parents who answered the survey were pleased with the quality of care provided, the facilities where care is provided, the staff and the happiness of their children.

Most parents strongly agreed that we offer excellent development opportunities at our setting, with one only one parent selecting "agree" as opposed to "strongly agree".

When answering the question about ease of communication with staff, most parents selected "strongly agree" that we are friendly and easy to speak with. Two parents selected "agree".

CHILDRENS FEEDBACK SUMMARY






